The presentation *A U.S. Postal Stationery Sampler - Part 1: The Nesbitt Issues* by member G. Radebaugh is the program for January 21<sup>st</sup>. The first U. S. stamped envelopes were issued in 1853. These envelopes and those issued through 1870 were printed by George F. Nesbitt and company. This talk will cover the stamped envelopes and wrappers issued during this period.
